It is truly our desire to keep going onward and upward with this wonderful ministry of trying to share the Gospel with the continent of Africa. But yet, I want to be quick to say that it would be impossible for this work to continue to go on were it not for all of you who pray for us regularly, and for those of you who are a part of our financial support team. GIMI is truly a team effort, and all of you are a vital part of this team. We need you to keep helping us as we try to be faithful on this comeback and recovery. Please know that JoAnne and I really love all of you, and we thank you for your participation in this growing ministry. We are truly excited about what the future holds for GIMI, and we are going on just like we were 30 years old again. Of course, we hardly move as fast as we used to! But with the power of the Holy Spirit, we believe that God can and will renew and refresh us so that we can keep telling the old, old story that Jesus died on the cross and arose from the dead to give all of us eternal life!

A GREAT HARVEST ALREADY THIS YEAR!

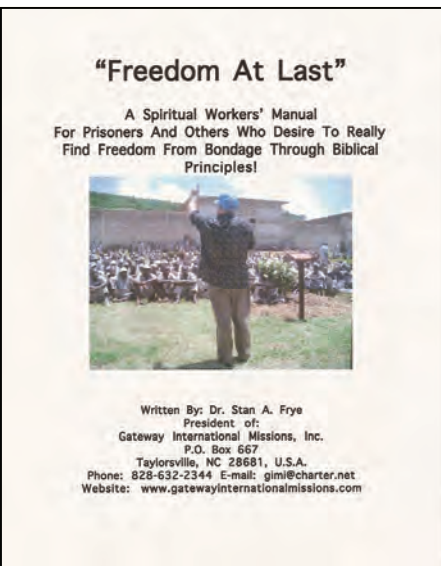
At the time of this writing, I am so happy to report that in spite of my sickness and even with the cancellation of some planned trips to Africa, our national preachers and teachers are really doing a marvelous job winning people to Christ in their various designated fields in Africa. Through the month of April of this year, our GIMI national preachers and one mission team from here in America have already shared the Gospel of Jesus Christ with over 271,126 people with over 60,239 of these praying to receive Jesus Christ as personal Savior. Praise God from Whom all blessings flow! God is a wonderful God Who is in the business of drawing people to Himself if we will be faithful to take His message to a lost world. **As I often say, whatever is given to GIMI financially is simply a demonstrated love gift to be used in a quest for souls for the Glory of God!**

Just a few days ago, I was talking to a pastor about the great harvest God has given to us through GIMI over the past 10 years. During my conversation with him, he asked me if anyone ever criticized the large numbers of people that we say have prayed to receive Christ. I told him that indeed they have, even to the extent that some of these skeptics even suggest that maybe we should not even be trying to win these people to Christ if we can't stay there personally and mentor every new believer who comes to Christ. Of course, I told him that these people were foolish because where did we ever get the idea that we should not try to win every man we possibly can to Jesus but instead, let people die and go to hell if we can't do a perfect job of discipleship. Yet, through our GIMI national preachers, we probably do as good a job of discipleship as we possibly could in both the prisons and schools. We use correspondence Bible studies for those who really want to grow in the Lord once they get saved, and then when a prisoner gets out of prison, we try to direct that former inmate to a good church back in the community where he or she came from. I think that I should say at this point that we're not the only people who face skeptics when we are seeing people come to Christ in large numbers. Jesus, Himself, had problems with the religious Pharisees and bigots everywhere He went, especially when the large crowds were leaving

the synagogues and following Jesus up into the mountains or out into the desert! Those who are hung up on traditional religion usually have no time for aggressive evangelistic crusades or intentional evangelism. I suppose that they believe that because they are so right and perfect in how they do the work of God, that if anyone wants their help, these helpless people should come to them and ask rather than them to dirty their hands and go after these lost hopeless people. I think that I will take my chances on trying to tell every lost person I can about Jesus, even if it is only a one time opportunity as I pass through a prison or school in Africa! **I am totally convinced that the object of the Great Commission is to take the Gospel of Jesus Christ to every man, woman, boy and girl that we possibly can while we have the opportunity! We are to start at the doors of our local churches and then go to the uttermost parts of the earth; all at the same time! It is not either or, but it is both and, all at the same time!**

I Have Finally Completed My Book!

Several years ago, a General in the Ghana Prison Service, General Israel Tsegah, asked me to really consider writing a prison manual for spiritual workers to use with prisoners. I told him that I would



seriously consider this project and if God gave me the liberty to do so, then I would try my best to complete this work. Well, over two years ago I began work on this project. Due to my recent stop with my open heart surgery, I was able to spend a lot of time at the computer writing, and by the grace of God I finally finished this work. Right now we are having this new book proof read, and before long we hope to have this book ready for distribution. The title of the

new book is **“Freedom At Last”**, “A Spiritual Worker’s Manual For Prisoners And Others”. This book is over 220 pages, and it covers many subjects such as salvation, the assurance of salvation, dealing with sexual temptation, dealing with loneliness, dealing with impatience, dealing with selfishness, and many other subjects that are very important to prisoners and those who are in bondage to sin. If you are interested in having a copy of this book, keep watching our web site and we will make it available very soon! You just need to go to the page entitled, **Dr. Stan’s Ministry**”, and open the page to “Resources”. We will post the book on this page and you can order the book with your credit card or Pay Pal account. I sincerely believe that God will use this book to help a lot of hurting and imprisoned people. I hope all of you will take advantage of the opportunity to get a copy for your home and even for your friends. I really believe you and they will be blessed by it.

The Greatest Needs We Have!

From time to time I will have a pastor or an individual ask me, “What are the greatest needs GIMI has?” Well truthfully, the greatest needs we always have are funds for shipping containers so that we can get the Bibles, Bible portions, Bible booklets, and other materials to the fields where our preachers can use them in their ministries. We recently shipped a container to Uganda for that country and Rwanda, and we have had about \$4,000 come in for a container to Kenya. But, we still need about \$8,000 more so that we can ship this container to Kenya and another one to Ghana, West Africa and Togo! If any of you can help us with these expenses, we would so much appreciate it.

The second greatest need that we have is for people to help us with the **“Prison Kids’ Boxes”**, for our kids in prison. We really need to collect as many of these as we can so that we can put them on our next two containers going out of our warehouse. We probably need at least 200 boxes within the months of July and August. If you could help with these, please contact **Rebecca McKinney** in our office and she will tell you what you need to do to prepare to fill these boxes. You can fill one box, or you might like to lead a Sunday School class, a youth group, an AWANA Club, or some other ministry in your church to become a part of this special ministry for our prison kids. These precious children go through so much suffering and if we can provide some very basic needs for these kids, they and their mothers will be blessed. And, I can assure you that you will be blessed because you have helped meet this great need!

The third greatest need that we have is for volunteers to make short term mission trips to Africa. We are always needing doctors, nurses, teachers, preachers, soul-winners, puppeteers, counselors, and many others who feel led of God to make a two week trip to one of our countries to help us share the Gospel of Jesus Christ through medical clinics, evangelism teams, school work, and even sometimes construction work. Just remember that thousands are waiting on you to help bring them the Gospel!

The fourth and final need that I will mention that is so great right now is for \$20,000 to print my new book, **“Freedom At Last”** so that we can supply this new book for as many prisoners as we possibly can. I can tell you that you could never give to a greater project than this. I sincerely believe that if every prisoner had the opportunity to read and study this new book, he or she would get saved and then begin a life of development in the Lord. Then from this book, they could learn some very practical truth that will help them prepare for the day they get out of prison so that they will never come back again! I hope that many of you will help us with this new project! **Remember! We need \$20,000 to help us print this new book so that God can use it to change the lives of scores of inmates! Will you please consider helping us?**

Before a word or two can be said, I want to inform you that we have arrived home safely. Our plane was delayed in Atlanta for one and half hours, due to heavy rains and thunderstorms. But our airline, LUFTHANSA, made a special arrangement for us in Frankfurt, so we did not miss our flight to Accra, Ghana. We believe that it was because all of you were praying for us.

Cecilia and I are still overwhelmed by the outstanding reception you gave us, the love of Jesus you showed, the concern for the ministry here in Ghana you demonstrated, and the outstanding generosity you displayed so powerfully. Cecilia and I salute all of you, and pray that whatever you lost because of us, God will multiply it in ten thousand fold back to you.

I must say here, that our ministry team that took care of the work while we were away, and did a good job. The ministry is still going well!

We are now putting things together for the huge Youth Camp in August. We are expecting over 1,300 people at camp this year. In fact, from this year going until 2015, when we will have the National Youth Camp, the numbers continue to go up a bit.

As some of you may be aware, we were not able to raise the needed funds for our 3 major and urgent needs. Namely . . . THE VAN, YOUTH CAMP, AND THE CAMP VILLAGE. We still need \$15,000 to enable us to meet these 3 urgent needs. So please, continue to pray with us, and help us raise the difference by the first week of August 2010.

Once again, I say, Cecilia and I are very, very GRATEFUL!

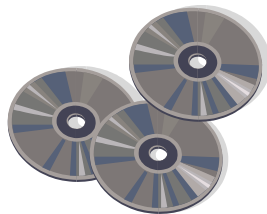
