Summer Greetings!

Dear Beloved Friends of GIMI,

Blessed Summer greetings to you in the precious name of Jesus! I trust that you are well, and that you are able to find a good place to stay cool during these hot Summer days. JoAnne and I have been extremely busy trying once again this year to plant a vegetable garden, and reap some of these wonderful vegetables which God has so graciously provided. Yes, with the doctor's permission, I have been able to get out and do some things that I really love and enjoy. I just have to be careful and not over do it during the hottest time of the day.

Also, I want to say that in spite of the fact that we were unable to make the long trip we had planned to visit some marvelous churches across the USA, we have been able to travel some short distances where I have been preaching in some great churches, and we have been telling these congregations about the ministry of GIMI. We had originally planned to make a 3,000 mile round trip to share the work with some dear pastors and church families. Hopefully, we will be able to go next year to these churches if my health keeps improving. I sincerely love and appreciate these pastors and their understanding about having to cancel this very long projected trip. Hopefully, before long, I will be well enough to go wherever God may open the doors.

Let me say that JoAnne and I sincerely appreciate all of the churches who are opening their doors for us to share the miracle of Gateway International Missions. And, I want to praise God for the scores of people that are getting saved here in the churches in America as well as on our fields in Africa and the Ukraine. Last year, 2010, God gave us a harvest of over 136,000 people praying to receive Christ, and just through the month of May this year, we have already seen over 30,000 people accept Christ as personal Savior. God is really using our national preachers on the fields in a glorious way. For instance, during the month of April alone, God gave us a harvest of over 3,000 souls praying to receive Christ in Kenya through the preaching of only seven preachers. Praise God for His saving power!

Where Is The Passion?

A few months ago I was studying the ministry of our resurrected Lord when He gave the twelve disciples the Great Commission. As I was digging deeply into the five accounts of where our Lord gave the disciples the Great Commission, suddenly it dawned upon me that our Lord gave twelve men the commission to take the Gospel message to the entire known world. And, they didn't have automobiles, airplanes, telephones, cell phones, computers, fax machines, I-pods, Black Berries, or any of the modern technology that we have today. Yet, they were given the Great Commission and over the next 30 plus years, they did indeed take the Gospel message to most of the known world. And sad to say, most of them died a martyr's death for the cause of the Gospel. And, this also included the Apostle Paul as well.

But, what about us today? Where is the passion in our hearts to make sure that every man, woman, boy, and girl on the earth gets the Good News of Jesus Christ? Where are the people that are willing to give up their lives so that multitudes of others can miss hell and spend eternity in heaven? Where are the totally surrendered disciples of this generation who will count the cost and pay the price to take the message of Jesus Christ to the world? The lost world is begging for genuinely passionate people who will live only for the purpose of sharing Jesus with those who have never heard. I must say that I have noticed most people down through the years, and they are bound and determined to be passionate about something or some cause. **What a refreshing thing it is from time to time to find someone who will say, "The only reason I live is that others may hear about Jesus"!** These people are hard to find, but from time to time, JoAnne and I run into one. And when we do, it is so encouraging. So, as we travel around America in scores of churches, we keep on looking for these passionate saints who will give up everything to follow Jesus and participate wholeheartedly in the proclamation of the Gospel.

The local church is the place where passionate believers should be called by God, and then these passionate children of God should be willing to pay the price and join the efforts of churches, mission organizations, and other groups to actively go so that

others may come to Christ. I trust that during these hot Summer months that all of us might seriously ask ourselves the question, **“Am I passionately sharing Jesus with a lost world?”** If we discover that we are not, may God help us to get out of the box and begin to participate with total abandonment in sharing Jesus with the lost world. I would like to ask many of you to seriously consider making the sacrifice to join one of our GIMI mission teams next year in going to Africa to get involved in front line missions. I would also encourage scores of you to also participate in helping GIMI financially so that we can continue to go with the Gospel message. JoAnne and I surrendered our lives many years ago to leading this ministry, but every day we are reminded that this is a team effort, and without the support and participation of numbers of you, we would never be able to continue this ministry. So, I plead with all of you to prayerfully consider praying for us, going with us on a mission trip, and giving very generously so that we can support our national preachers and teachers, ship Bibles and literature to Africa, and so that we can purchase food, soap, clothing, medicine, and many other items for these suffering people in Africa.

Please Pray For Our Next Trip

Most of you know that JoAnne and I have not been to Africa since March of 2010 due to my serious health issues. Yet, with the doctors permission, we are planning to return to Africa in September and October of this year. We ask you to really pray for us as we are making the plans to go, and I would like to ask you to consider giving to this trip so that we can buy all of the medicine, soap, clothing, and food items that we will need to distribute during our six weeks in Uganda, Rwanda, and Kenya. Pray also that God might really give us a great harvest of souls. And, please pray for the two small teams that will join us for our work in Uganda and Kenya.

And, since this is the July-August newsletter, let me ask you to really pray for Pastor Jeff Kautz and a team from Calvary Baptist Church, Lincolnton, NC which will be traveling to Ghana, West Africa during the first two weeks of August. This team is going to Ghana to work with Pastor James Baidoo in a boarding Vacation Bible School where 1,200 children and youth are scheduled to attend. Pray for the team’s safety in travel, and also for another great harvest of souls. Last year, this VBS Camp had 1,000 children and youth that attended, and 372 people got saved. So, let’s pray that this year, scores of these participants will come to Jesus. We do all that we do for the purpose of seeing people enter the Kingdom.

We Need To Ship A Container To Uganda

Most of you know that over the past several months GIMI has shipped two very important containers to Africa. The first one went to Ghana with materials for Ghana and Togo. The second one is to arrive any day now in Nairobi, Kenya with thousands of copies of God’s Word and Scripture portions on it to be used in the ministry there. **Recently, I learned from our Uganda Director, Rev. William Ssentumbwe, that we are running low on materials in Uganda. Folks, we really need your help to ship a container with Bible’s, Scripture portions, and thousands of Gospel tracts and booklets to Uganda, and we need to ship these right away. The cost will be approximately \$8,000, due to the fact that we have to haul the container 1,000 miles over land from the port in Mombasa. So, will you please help us with this right away? We really need to get this container to Uganda just as soon as we can!**

West Virginia Christmas Party

In our last GIMI newsletter, I shared with you that in December of this year, GIMI is going to sponsor a West Virginia Christmas party in Bartow, W.Va.. In order for us to help 100 families, folks, we really need your help. I would like to ask all of you pastors and churches, especially within driving distance of our headquarters and offices here in North Carolina, to begin to collect good used clothing, coats, hats, caps, nonperishable food items, blankets, new sheets, pillows, etc. to help us provide for these one hundred families in the Appalachian Mountains of West Virginia. We would also ask you to consider helping us financially so that we can purchase special food items such as turkeys, hams, etc. for this special Christmas Party For Jesus. Our primary goal for this American event is to preach Jesus Christ to all of those who attend the Christmas party. So, if you would like to help, we have included a list of needed items on the next page of this newsletter. Also, if you have additional questions, please contact Pastor Jeff Kautz at our GIMI office, and he can help answer your questions. **Please! Please! Consider helping us meet the needs of some of our very own American people who have been out of work, and have suffered many difficult circumstances. Just remember that we are trying desperately to help Sister Janet Hart minister to these dear people in West Virginia, and most of all, we want to see them get saved.**

Well, let me close for this time. I pray that you will stay busy sharing Jesus with a lost and dying world. And, please partner with us as we seek to win men to Christ just before the soon coming of our precious Lord Jesus! Thanks to all you that are already helping us. We love and appreciate you so much!

PERSONAL TESTIMONY OF MUGENZI BONIFACE

I, MUGENZI Boniface, age 29 years old, was born into an unchristian family where my father had two wives. Before I became a Christian man, I practiced the same behaviors as my father and I married two wives. I separated with the first one called Nyiransabimana Sauda four years ago, we had two children. Then I married the second wife called Ntawiha Marceline, and we have one child.

I, Mugenzi Faraji who became Boniface (Christian name), I entered the Islam religion since 2002. Since that time, I have changed 21 persons into Islam. I grew up in the unchristian educations such as drinking alcohol, fighting . . . where I taught that there is one Lord "ALLAH" and Jesus who is a prophet.

In January 2011, I met Bishop GAPIRA Jean Faustin in the Christian evangelization who challenged me about salvation, he



gave me some Bible tracts. I have been helped a lot by a spiritual booklet titled "WHEN ALL HOPE IS GONE" with some Bible verses, written by a Servant of God called Dr. Stan Frye. Three months ago I was baptized by Bishop Gapira in Christian Light Church where I have been called to be the light of the world (Matthew 5:14-15). I could not pretend to be changed into a Christian man as I am. Praise the Lord.

From there, my life was totally changed, for anything concerning Christian advices and behaviors, I could check with Servant of God, Bishop Gapira Jean Faustin who became my discipler. My goal is to evangelize first of all my friends whom I have sensitized to become the Muslims, so that they may know exactly the salvation of Jesus Christ.

As you already know, the Annual Youth Camp starts on August 7th thru August 13th, 2011. And, as usual, Satan is at his best to discourage, intimidate, and block every blessing we need to organize this great outreach program.

As I write to you now, there is so much pressure on us from every school to increase the number of students coming to camp this year. What makes this so interesting and encouraging is that this time it is not the school authorities who want more of their students to come, but the parents of the students. As 5 parents in the VOLTA REGION puts it: SINCE OUR CHILDREN CAME BACK HOME FROM YOUTH CAMP LAST YEAR, WE HAVE SEEN A GREAT CHANGE IN THEIR LIFE.

Dear faithful friends, the School ministry is really having an impact on these young men and women. At least 1,300 students are coming to the camp this year.

Please pray with us that the Lord will touch people's hearts to give generously towards the expenses of the camp. We need \$15,000.00 to run the camp. And please pray also that there will be no accident whatsoever, as we experienced last year with my wife Cecilia breaking her leg, which up till now, she has not healed properly.

Atomic Hills Baptist Church and the Prison Ministries are also doing really well.

For example, on June 21, 2011, I preached at Nsawam Male Prison, the biggest Prison in Ghana and over 30 people prayed to receive Jesus Christ as their personal Savior. We had a great service.
