Blessed Happy Thanksgiving Greetings to you in the precious name of Jesus! It is so hard for me to believe that Thanksgiving Day is here again in America, and yes, even to think that the Christmas season is here as well. JoAnne and I sincerely want to wish you and your family and friends a wonderful Christ-exalting Thanksgiving Season celebration. "Thanksgiving is a national holiday in the United States, celebrated on the fourth Thursday of November. It originated as a harvest festival. Thanksgiving has been celebrated nationally on and off since 1789, with a proclamation by George Washington, after a request by Congress. Thomas Jefferson (who was a Deist, and not a Christian) chose not to observe the holiday, and its celebration was intermittent until the presidency of Abraham Lincoln, when Thanksgiving became a federal

holiday in 1863, during the American Civil War. Lincoln proclaimed a national day of 'Thanksgiving and Praise to our beneficent Father who dwells in the Heavens,' to be celebrated on the last Thursday in November."

"The event that Americans commonly call the 'First Thanksgiving' was celebrated by the Pilgrims after their first harvest in the New World in October 1621. This feast lasted three days, and—as accounted by attendee Edward Wilson—it was attended by 90 Native Americans and 53 Pilgrims."

Friends, Thanksgiving is a very special time of the year for every American who has been blessed to live in this country, but for those of us who have genuinely been saved by the blood of Jesus Christ, it is truly a time to reflect upon the goodness of God because He has blessed us in so many ways. Most of you know that my dear wife and I have been working in Africa for almost 40 years (Since 1985). I can't remember any Christmas when we did not do our best to raise thousands and thousands of dollars in order to share Jesus with millions of people in Africa, in the Ukraine, and here in America. We have been successful in seeing thousands come to Christ in all of our countries. We have been able to provide thousands of Bibles, Bible booklets, new convert materials, and on and on I could go! With the help of Samaritan's Purse in Boone, N.C., (many years ago), providing some wonderful hospital refurbishment, we have been able to restore three prison hospitals in Africa. In addition, with the help of so many of God's people as individuals, in churches, in businesses, and in other organizations, God has provided for us. God's provision helps alleviate so much suffering caused by; the economy, wars, terrorist attacks, the Covid Pandemic, a volcano eruption, the death and imprisonment of husbands leaving widows and children behind, drought after drought, and flood after flood. Several of our African workers' family members, the families of our very own pastors who died in accidents in several of our countries, and millions of people have been blessed by your giving. God has truly blessed! There is so much more that needs to be done! SO, WILL YOU PLEASE HELP US CONTINUE THIS GREAT MINISTRY THIS CHRISTMAS? I sincerely hope you can help us! I promise you that if you will, Jesus will tremendously bless you over and over (Matthew 10:42).

THE COWS ARE COMING ONCE AGAIN!

A number of you that are GIMI Team Members and Friends know that for many years that GIMI has bought hundreds of beef cows (Most from the Uganda prison farms) to provide meat for the prisoners in Uganda on Christmas Day. We inherited this wonderful meat provision project from our Predecessors, Mickey and Alice Parrish, (who are now up in heaven with Jesus), who started this great ministry while living in Jacksonville, Florida. And, it was while my family and I were living in Jacksonville, where I was trying to complete my seminary education. It was down there that I began working in prisons with brother Mickey, Jim Williams, and several others from the then great First Baptist Church. You might say I was broken in well because they took me straight to death row where I began to share Christ with a few "unknown prisoners, like David Washington, Ted Bundy, and many other condemned prisoners. This was the beginning of mine and my wife's 48 years in the ministry for prisoners.

Now, let me get back to the cows! Two years ago, we were not able to buy the cows in Uganda due to the herds of cows having Foot and Mouth disease. So, we provided many other wonderful Christmas gifts in all of our countries during that year. And, because so many of you, our friends and supporters, helped us so generously, we were able to spend over \$100,000 to help meet the needs of several thousand people who would have had no Christmas, and a huge number of people in our 12 countries would not have had food to eat or medicine to help heal their sicknesses. I want to give you

a list of some of the hundreds of items we purchased for Christmas. Because of your faithful and generous support, we were able to purchase a huge amount of Christmas food, blankets, clothing, medicine, and, a lot of small gifts for those who are suffering so much daily. Also, because of your eternal investment in the ministry, we were able to provide some small gifts for our 50 plus field workers, who do a super job sharing the Gospel to thousands of people, and also, are helping minister to so many hurting and suffering people.

Yes, two years back when we could not buy the cows, we were able to purchase a huge number of gifts and other necessary items. Then, last year, we were able to purchase over 50 cows to help feed the suffering prisoners in Uganda. We bought these cows, and yes, thousands of other humanitarian items to minister to all of the people we are daily trying to minister to in all of our countries.

"WE BEG YOU TO HELP US ONCE AGAIN THIS YEAR!"

Last year, we purchased somewhere around 50 cows. This year, we believe the cost will be between \$300-\$350 per cow, but I promise you that we are now negotiating the cost of these muchneeded animals. And may I say, that everyone gets so excited about providing meat on Christmas Day, unless of course it is left-wing Congresswoman Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez and her crazy friends. Obviously, they don't read the Bible, because Paul told young Timothy the following in I Timothy 4:1-3—"Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron; Forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth." These weird people need Jesus so desperately because they have no idea what truth is. If you don't believe this, just stop and see if you might be able to count the times that many of our politicians in Washington may have told the truth during this continuing year. Folks, I never thought we would ever live to see so many of the, (so-called) leaders in Washington, and yes, some other local leaders who would never get around to speaking the truth, but almost every time they open their mouths, they lie with no conviction about what they are doing being wrong. "We Must Revive Our GIMI Radio Ministry"

I say we must revive our radio ministry very soon, because for about two years, we had been broadcasting on about 40 radio stations in Africa, and some here in America. Of course, when we started the radio ministry a few years back, we started with over 90 stations, but the cost was just too much! Then, after about 18 months later, I came down with the throat problem, which caused me to stop for the time being. Following this problem, I had my vocal cords replaced. After this surgery and recovery, I restarted the broadcast. In a few months I had more throat problems, and had to stop the broadcasting again for the second time. Now, for the past several months I have not done any new broadcasts, but in Uganda at three radio stations they have been replaying my broadcasts, and most important of all, hundreds of people are still getting saved. We praise the Lord for what He is doing! Now, I desperately want to begin the broadcasting myself once more. So, my present goal is to hopefully get started again on the first weekend of January, 2025. Therefore, I want to literally beg you dear GIMI Team Members, first to fervently pray for God to give me the strength to continue this great radio ministry. Secondly, we really need your financial help to pay for the airtime. Airtime these days is very expensive, but, beloved friends, because of the hundreds and hundreds of people that are being saved through this ministry, whatever the cost, it is surely worth the cost because Jesus is going to return very soon, and there are two billion people on this earth that have never been saved, and most of them have not even heard or seen the plan of salvation. SO, MY DEAR FRIENDS, IF WE ARE ALL GOING TO LEAVE ALL OF THIS EARHTLY WEALTH VERY SOON, WE MUST TRY TO WIN PEOPLE FOR JESUS, AND LAY UP TREASURE IN HEAVEN WHERE MOTH AND RUST CAN'T CORRUPT OUR HEAVENLY TREASURE (Matthew 6:19). THEREFORE, BELOVED GIMI FRIENDS AND SUPPORTERS, WILL YOU PLEASE HELP US BY SENDING THE BIGGEST GIFT YOU CAN POSSIBLY SEND AT THIS TIME? IF YOU WILL, I KNOW GOD IS GOING TO BLESS YOU ENORMOUSLY! (Luke 6:38; Hebrews 6:10).

There is one more thing I want to share with you before I move on and stop talking about our radio ministry. In many of the large prisons in all of our countries in Africa, there are no radios for the prisoners to hear the Gospel. Thus, could you please send some funds to help us buy some large radios for some of the large prisons? The cost of these large radios is about \$300 each. Therefore, if you can help us with purchasing these radios, you will be helping us to share the Gospel with thousands of prisoners. I hope and pray that you as individuals, as families, as businesses, and as churches, you will give sacrificially to help us tell the real meaning of Christmas to multitudes of prisoners, orphans, schools, and refugee camps. Please send your gifts in the enclosed envelopes, and designate them for buying radios, or, for paying for airtime!

Beloved brothers and sisters, every time I write my articles for our newsletter, I truly get broken, and sometimes shed tears due to what God has chosen to do through this small ministry in the past 24 years. Without a doubt, God has His hand upon the way we do missions, how we gather the harvest, and so many other areas where we are witnessing Him move majestically in our 12 countries in Africa, through our radio ministry in Africa and in America, and especially, through our ministry in the prisons and schools. I know that sometimes our readers don't believe the huge results we are telling that is happening every month. We do our best to follow up on all of the people who have asked Jesus to come into their hearts. As I have told you before, in the parable of the sower there were four kinds of soil mentioned in the parable, but only one kind was genuine. Based upon this, we probably are seeing some that make professions of faith, but their decision is not genuine. And, as I always say, "probably only one fourth of church members are genuinely saved people. Therefore, just like in the Bible preaching churches, we continue to preach the Gospel of our Lord Jesus. All of the work in the churches is done by only about 25% of the people. Believe it or not, only about 7% of professing Christians are committed to giving themselves and their God-given offerings back to Jesus, even after He gave His life on the cross for every person who has ever walked on this planet. We must not forget the slogan God gave me a few years back. This slogan says:

YOU DON'T HAVE REAL SALVATION IF YOU DON'T FEEL OBLIGATED TO TAKE IT TO THE REST OF THE WORLD TO SHOW YOUR APPRECIATION TO JESUS!!

Beloved GIMI Team members, we must keep going on to present the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ to as many people as possible, even if many of the decisions are not real. As one great leader here in America used to say, "it is only our responsibility to present the Gospel in the power of the Holy Spirit, and leave the results to God." No greater statement could ever be said than this statement. Thus, we must move on with the proclamation of the Gospel to win as many people as possible here just before the time when Jesus is coming again!

As I have told you before, during the past 24 years since my wife and I took over this ministry, we have shared the Gospel with over 38 million people, with just over 7 million of these people making first-time professions of faith in our Lord Jesus. And beloved team members, I know you will rejoice with us in knowing that from January-September of this year, we have been able to share the Gospel with over 1,171,231 people. And from these large

numbers, just over 293,947 people have made their first-time professions of faith in our Lord Jesus Christ! Could you please join us in saying, "Praise God, Hallelujah to our Lord Jesus Christ, and Amen! Amen!

I also want to say that every week through our wonderful national preachers and teachers on the fields, we are seeing hundreds and hundreds of these converts "grow in grace and in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. To Him, be the glory, both now and forever. Amen!" (II Peter 3:18) Also, I want to tell you that because our primary ministry is in the prisons of Africa, we are seeing scores of inmates released from prison after their lives have been gloriously changed by the power of our Lord Jesus Christ. Because they become new creatures in Christ, God provides forgiveness, and many times, the prison officials see such a difference that they send them back home to be with their families! Praise the Lord!

As we thank God for this wonderful spiritual harvest at this Thanksgiving time of the year, let me give you some wonderful Scripture, which I wrote a commentary on a few years back on the **Book** of II Corinthians. Please pay close attention to this Thanksgiving message. "But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully. Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work: (As it is written, He hath dispersed abroad; he hath given to the poor: his righteousness remaineth forever. Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness;) Being enriched in everything to all bountifulness, which causeth through us thanksgiving to God. For the administration of this service not only supplieth the want of the saints; but is abundant also by many thanksgivings unto God; Whiles by the experiment of this ministration they glorify God for your professed subjection unto the gospel of Christ, and for your liberal distribution unto them, and unto all men; And by their prayer for you, which long after you for the exceeding grace of God in you. Thanks be unto God for His unspeakable gift." (II **Corinthians 9:6-15.)** This is quite a long passage of Scripture, but it is filled with Biblical truth and principles. Some of those principles are:

- 1. We must learn to give bountifully, for if we don't, our harvest will be sparse. v. 6
- 2. We must learn to give bountifully with a Godly purpose in mind. v. 7a
- 3. We must learn to give cheerfully, because God loves a cheerful giver. v. 7b
- 4. We must learn to give to others, because God will give more grace when grace has been shown to others. v. 8a
- 5. We must learn to completely depend upon the graciousness of God in His meeting our every need, so that in turn, we may do good work in ministering to others. v. 8b

- 6. We must learn to give to the poor, because, this righteous deed will never be forgotten by our Lord. v. 9
- 7. We must learn to trust God to provide our food, and we demonstrate this trust when we sow good seed by investing in others who are in need. v. 10
- 8. We must learn that when we give bountifully by investing in those who are poor and suffering, then others will offer thanksgiving to God because of what we have done in His name. v. 11
- 9. We must learn that when we give offerings to minister to those in need, like those in the Jerusalem church for which the Corinthians were receiving an offering. Then, those to whom we have given will offer much thanksgiving to God for our ministry to them. v. 12
- 10. We must learn that when we give offerings to help those in need, we are displaying that we are genuine believers who are truly sharing liberally because of our relationship with Christ. v. 13
- 11. We must learn that when we minister to the suffering, then they are prone to offer fervent prayers on our behalf. v. 14a
- 12. We must learn that when we minister to the suffering, then, the recipients of our ministry will prayerfully long for the type of graciousness we have demonstrated to them. v. 14b
- 13. We must learn that the greatest way to offer true thanksgiving is to demonstrate help to alleviate the suffering of those who are hurting, who in turn will thank God for the unspeakable gift of the Gospel message. v. 15

Now, what is the summary on of all of these Biblical principles, which Paul gave to the Corinthian church and to us as well? The summary on this is that when we as God's people learn the joy of giving cheerfully to those who are in need of the Gospel or are in tremendous poverty, then, we have demonstrated the true Gospel message. Thus, those who give cheerfully will be offering thanksgiving for the privilege to give, and then, those who receive from our kind generosity, will also offer tremendous praise and thanksgiving to God for touching our hearts to lead us to give! In other words, there will be Thanksgiving all around!

A Glorious Day Of Freedom For Prisoner Alicia In Kenya!

As I start this short article, I want to tell you that I am sharing with you a victorious celebration. Please notice the young lady that is the second person from the left in the photo. Her name is Alicia, and she is a single mother who has spent the past ten years in a Kenya prison. Shortly after she came to Kenya and was arrested and put into the main women's prison in Nairobi, my dear wife and I went to Kenya on one of our many mission trips. During this trip we went to the large prison where Alicia had been placed. That day, I preached the Gospel to all of these lady prisoners, and JoAnne distributed many blankets and other gifts. During my evangelistic invitation, Alicia surrendered her life to Jesus and got saved. Since that very long time ago, Alicia has stayed faithful to Christ, and she has corresponded with my wife from that day until recently. After praying with Alicia, and for her mother and three children down in South Africa, we just kept believing that one day God would open the prison doors, and she would be able to come out and be free again. It was a very long ten years, but Alicia stayed faithful to Jesus, and she grew in the Lord immensely. She became a tremendous influence on the other prisoners, many of which gave their hearts to Jesus because of her testimony. A few weeks back, God gloriously answered our prayers and the Kenya judicial system released her so she could return to South Africa and be with her three children and her mother. The photo here shows us this precious young lady standing outside the prison with GIMI pastor, Sammy Mbugua, who has ministered to Alicia for years and years. Here he stands with Alicia and some of the South African Embassy personnel as Alicia is set free and let out of prison. With the help of so many of you dear faithful financial contributors to GIMI, we have been able to give many gifts to Alicia and the other prisoners there in this Kenya prison. Because of your financial help, we were able to pay for her plane ticket to take her back home to live with her mom and children. Truly, this is a time for Christian thanksgiving celebration to praise Jesus for Alicia's release, and her return home. The wonderful thing about this story is that when Alicia went into a Kenya prison ten plus years ago, she went in as a prisoner for a sinful deed. After she got gloriously saved, one day when my dear wife and I went there to share the Good News of our Lord Jesus Christ, she was set free from the prison of sin, and then, after all of these years, God has also set her free from imprisonment. Truly, the following verse in the Gospel of John speaks mightily. Please notice what Jesus told His disciples and many other people who were that day: "And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free (John 8:32). Surely, Alicia was first set free from the imprisonment of sin. Then, many years later, Jesus

answered our prayers and set her free literally! Praise the Lord! She is now free from the power of sin, and from literal incarceration. Truly, God needs to be praised for all of the people on this earth that are now free because of what Jesus has done for all of us!!!

At the risk of being called crazy and arrogant, I would like to state emphatically that I know of no mission organization on earth that sees as many people come to Christ for the money spent as does GIMI. I say this because, several years ago a young cocky preacher in Eastern North Carolina convinced his senior pastor to stop supporting GIMI because I had made this statement before. This young punk pastor wrote me a terrible accusatory letter calling me a liar, telling me that I had exaggerated our numbers! When I said at that meeting, we got someone saved for every \$3.00 we spent, this young whippersnapper got so mad that he had to write a three-page letter rebuking this old preacher! Yet, his pastor went along with this young professing preacher and signed the letter. The truth is that presently, for every \$3.00 we spend, we see some person come to Christ! You might wonder how this is possible! Well, the truth is that we can do this by using our African nationals who don't require \$80,000 plus dollars per person each year to send American missionaries to our fields. Oh yes, we need our American brothers and sisters to go to Africa and share the Gospel, train our leaders, and encourage our workers, but instead of paying \$80,000 per missionary, because of the African economies, we are able to preach and teach the Gospel for \$300 or less per month, per person. So, instead of \$80,000 per missionary, we are able to do so much more with \$2,400-\$3,600 per national worker. And truthfully, this is a lot of money for them. Thus, we are seeing multitudes come to Christ because of the faithfulness of our dear African people.

I want all of you precious GIMI Team Members to really say a prayer of Thanksgiving for all of our GIMI national workers. They are doing so much good for the least of expenses, and we should be thanking them from the depths of our hearts. And may I say, there is just no way that this great ministry could continue to see so many people saved without the faithfulness of our nationals! May God bless all of you dear servants of God in Africa, in the Ukraine, and here in America. I also want to offer Thanksgiving to Jesus for Sister T.J.
