Blessed spring greetings in the precious named of Jesus! I pray you and your family are safe and well in these worsening days just before the return of our wonderful Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ! I say that the days are worsening, simply because the Bible tells us that this was going to happen. In Paul's last letter written from a horrible Roman prison cell, just before he was beheaded by Nero in Rome, Paul told Timothy and the believers at Ephesus that just before the return of Christ coming back to this earth to finalize His Kingdom, things would get worse and worse. This decline would come very rapidly. The worsening of evil and apostasy would become very evident and draw attention to the progressive debauchery, immorality, lawlessness, and covetousness which would be so very escalated just before King Jesus would split the Eastern sky and rapture His church. My dear beloved Christian brothers and sisters, because of the terrible revealing signs that are all

around us, I believe the coming of Christ for His raptured Church could be any moment! If you don't believe this, let me direct your attention to a Scripture that profoundly reveals just what I am writing about in this spring newsletter article. For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, Traitors, heady, high-minded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts, Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth (II Timothy 3:1-7).

My dearly beloved Christian friends, if these previous seven verses of Scripture don't get your attention, and warn you of the declining moral and cultural conditions that are promised to come just before the return of Jesus, I don't know what it might

take to get you ready for the soon-coming return of Jesus! Every word that Paul gave to every believer in this final epistle of Paul, gives an explicit description of just how bad things are going to be when Jesus returns to rapture His Bride. These seven verses should cause every human being to fall down on his or her knees and cry out in repentance, and beg Jesus to save their souls. Pray that He will give them the assurance that he or she is genuinely saved or born-again, and is ready to depart this earth and rise up to meet Jesus in the air! Friends, I don't believe there is a greater passage of Scripture anywhere in the Bible that gives a greater warning of imminent fear, and begs for God to forgive every lost sinner that will ask by faith for forgiveness. My explicit question to each of you readers is, "Are you ready to meet Jesus?" If you aren't, why don't you just lay this news article down, and repent of your sins, and ask Jesus to save your soul this very day? If you will do this, it will be the greatest day in your entire life!!"

"A Begging Request For Your Fervent Prayers!"

Through nearly 60 years of full-time ministry, I have asked our friends and readers to please pray about many specific prayer requests. Most of you regular prayer warriors and GIMI Team Members know that GIMI has been working in 12-15 African countries regularly, plus, in the troubled war-torn Ukraine, and throughout America for over 25 years. Today JoAnne and I, along with all of our GIMI Board Members, want to ask you to literally get down on your knees and begin to pray for the following request. We are begging you to pray fervently about a terrible situation in our DR Congo ministry. For many years, GIMI has worked in the DR Congo; one of the most troubled and dangerous places on the earth. In the northeastern part of the DR Congo, there are over 200 terrorist groups in the beautiful Rwenzori Mountains. The number of terrorist groups have exploded since the bloody genocide that killed almost one million people during the 1994 war in just 100 days in Rwenzori. During this bloodbath, the Hutu Tribe that controlled Rwanda was defeated by the Tutsi Tribe under the leadership of Paul Kagame. Following the 100 days of killing and slaughtering, thousands of people had to flee the country, many of which ended up in the Rwenzori Mountains. Since that bloodbath, these 200 terrorist groups have caused havoc almost non-stop, except when some of the armies in a few of the adjoining countries brought their armies into the DR Congo to stop a lot of the killing. But recently, probably one of the worst terrorist groups, M23, has begun to try and take over eastern DR Congo. They have killed thousands of people, and recently, they have overtaken Goma, the eastern capitol of the country, plus, Bukavu, another very large city nearby. In the last couple of months, over 500,000 refugees have had to flee the country to Rwanda, Burundi, Tanzania, Uganda, and a couple more countries in order to stay alive.

GIMI presently has three great preachers who have been working with us in the DR Congo for a very long time. Our Country Director is Pastor Israel Ngirababo. Then, we have Pastor Robert Ndinayo, and Pastor Benjamin Patient, who have been doing a splendid job of sharing the Gospel. Tragically, all three of our preachers

have had to flee their homes with their families, and cross over into another country. Because of this horrible terrorist thuggery, our pastors and their beautiful families have lost everything, including their houses and all of their personal items. They are now living in refugee camps, and unable to preach in their churches. Folks, please, please, pray for these dear servants of God and their families. Please pray that they will soon be able to return to their own country and begin rebuilding their church families, and church buildings, most of which have been destroyed! Beloved Brothers and Sisters, this is truly one of the worst attacks of Satan that our GIMI Ministry has ever had. I believe the main reason the devil has done this is because of the faithfulness of our pastors and their families, and because of the great harvest of souls that Jesus has been giving us. These three servants of God are some of the best men of God we have ever had. **PLEASE PRAY FERVENTLY FOR THESE WONDERFUL SERVANTS OF GOD AND THIS TERRIBLE SITUATION! ALSO, IF ANY OF YOU MIGHT HAVE SOME EXTRA FUNDS THAT YOU MIGHT BE ABLE TO GIVE TO HELP THESE SUFFERING SERVANTS, PLEASE SEND IT TO US, AND WE WILL SEND IT ON TO THEM WITH THE ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF WHERE THE GIFTS HAVE COME FROM. BELOVED GIMI TEAM MEMBERS, FOR OVER 25 YEARS, GIMI HAS RAISED AND DISTRIBUTED MILLIONS OF DOLLARS FOR SUFFERING PEOPLE. 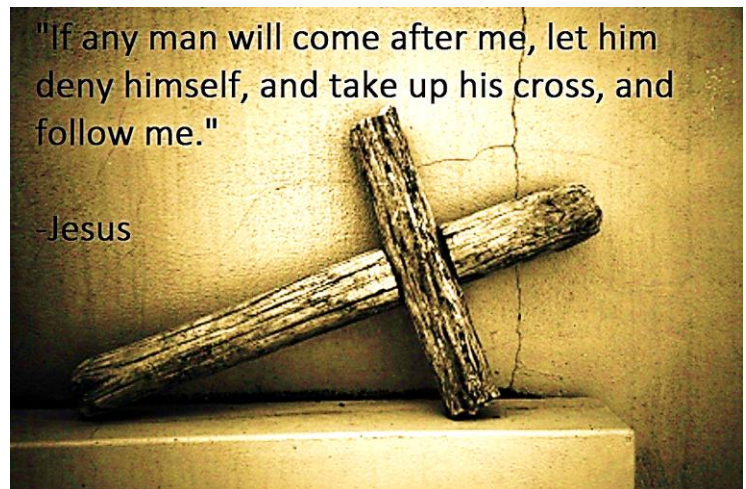

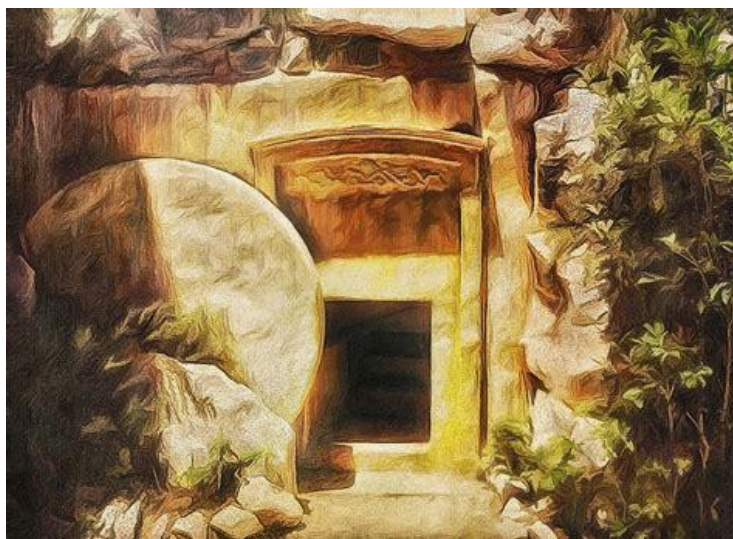

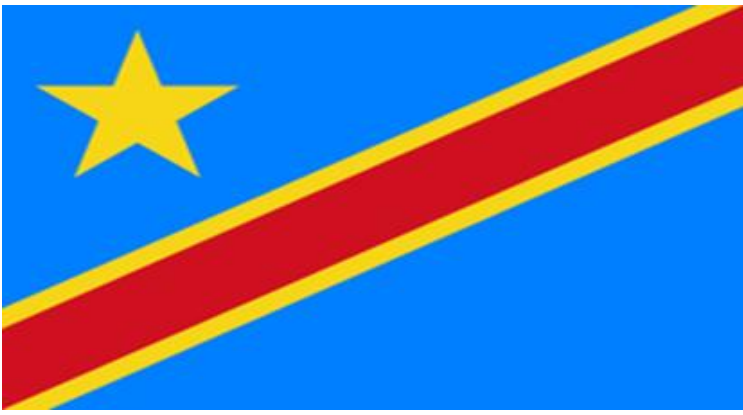
