Scripture: Ephesians 6:1-20

Introduction:

In the modern world in which we live today, it would seem that professing Christians have envisioned serving Christ as a carefree joy party in which there are to be no problems, no setbacks, and no sacrifice. We even have scores of hypocritical pastors and evangelists who are preaching a false gospel telling their people that if you have enough faith, you will never be sick, never be poor, and always flourish in everything you do. May I say that this is utterly ridiculous!

Some people say that the church should be a museum where we display our Christian talents and trophies. Others say that the church should just be a hospital to help the hurting. But, the Bible tells us that when we get saved, we have just joined God's army and are now training for conflict and imminent battle. This might discourage some of us, but the truth is, we have an archenemy named Satan, and he will wage war until the day he is cast into the Lake of Fire. My question to you today is, "What kind of solider are you on the battlefield for our Lord?" Today, we will discover some wonderful truth that will help us to improve our military readiness to fight the devil, our enemy. Please pay attention to what God wants to say to us through Paul the great Apostle!

 - 2. Their means is conscription of deputy demons. (Delegated demons)
 - 3. Their means is conscription of deceiving demons. (Blinding demons)- False cults, phony preachers, believing lies.
 - 4. Their means is conscription of dominating demons. (Bondage demons)- Controlling habits: pornography, alcohol, tobacco, drugs, sexual immorality, obsession with gossip, slander, etc.)

D. We need to understand their method. v. 12c (Demon control in world leaders)
